

PA Tax Credit Program 

What is it?
 An opportunity to earn a 90% state-tax credit and provide scholarships to students at St. Ignatius Loyola School.

How do I qualify?
 You or your spouse work for a for-profit business or own a business.
 You pay at least \$1000 in state tax.

How do I apply?
 Fill in a one-page Joinder Agreement to direct where your PA taxes go and make your initial contribution.

How does this work?
 You become a member of an LLC or SPE (Special Purpose Entity) and receive a K-1 to earn your PA tax credit.

PA STATE TAX CREDIT PROGRAM

Do you want to direct where your PA Tax dollars are spent?
 Would you like to use your tax dollars to help a family at St. Ignatius who is struggling to pay tuition?
 You can do that with one simple form!
 The process is very easy!

Reach out to Dr. Wood and fill in a form that goes to a local scholarship foundation who will handle all the steps for you. Write a check and receive a form that allows you to receive a 90% PA tax credit. For example, if you pay \$1,000 in taxes, you will receive a \$900 tax credit.

Whether you are an individual who works for a for-profit business or own your own business, you can participate in the SPE (Special Purpose Entity) which allows you to obtain

EITC (Educational Improvement Tax Credit) or OSTC (Opportunity Scholarship Tax Credit). There is still money available for the 2023 tax year from three local scholarship funds.

GOD'S PLAN FOR GIVING

Today's readings are all about love - the radical love of God for His people and the radical love we are called to live out in response. The stewardship way of life is nothing more and nothing less than the practical application of loving God and neighbor in our daily lives.

Jesus sums up the message of all the prophets, as well as the purpose of all God's laws in today's Gospel passage, from Matthew. It is a message we have likely grown up hearing - but it is so beautiful and so challenging, it bears repeating again and again. It is Christ's response to a question about which commandment is greatest. His answer reveals both the greatest and the second greatest commandments.

He says, "You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind... The second is like it: you shall love your neighbor as yourself."

How is the second like the first? What do the two commands have in common? Love.

Love God first and love neighbor as self. This is the heart of the stewardship way of life - simple enough for a child to understand, challenging enough to be the life's work of every "grown-up."
