What is it?
 An opportunity to earn a 90% state-tax credit and provide scholarships to students at St. Ignatius Loyola School.

How do I qualify?
 You or your spouse work for a for-profit business or own a business.
 You pay at least \$1000 in state tax.

How do I apply?
 Fill in a one-page Joinder Agreement to direct where your PA taxes go and make your initial contribution.

How does this work?
 You become a member of an LLC or SPE (Special Purpose Entity) and receive a K-1 to earn your PA tax credit.

PA STATE TAX CREDIT PROGRAM

Do you want to direct where your PA Tax dollars are spent?
 Would you like to use your tax dollars to help a family at St. Ignatius who is struggling to pay tuition?
 You can do that with one simple form!
 The process is very easy!

Reach out to Dr. Wood and fill in a form that goes to a local scholarship foundation who will handle all the steps for you. Write a check and receive a form that allows you to receive a 90% PA tax credit. For example, if you pay \$1,000 in taxes, you will receive a \$900 tax credit.

Whether you are an individual who works for a for-profit business or own your own business, you can participate in the SPE (Special Purpose Entity) which allows you to obtain EITC (Educational Improvement Tax Credit) or OSTC (Opportunity Scholarship Tax Credit). There is still money available for the 2023 tax year from three local scholarship funds.

ACTIVE PARISHIONER STATUS FOR SPONSORSHIP

We receive many requests from parishioners to be a godparent or sponsor for the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation. Part of that request is to be able to verify that a person is an "active member" of our Parish.

An "active member" of this parish is one who

- Is properly registered
 - Faithfully attends Mass on Sundays/Holy Days
 - If married, must be validly married, i.e., married in a Catholic Church by a priest or deacon
 - If single, must be 16 years of age and received the Sacrament of Confirmation
 - Participates in parish activities when possible
 - Regularly contributes through the Sunday offertory collection by use of the parish envelope system or direct withdrawal.
- (your envelope use confirms attendance at Mass)*

While assessments of an inquirer's status will be made individually, the above are the main factors considered in making that determination.

Today's readings encourage us Christian stewards to always be mindful of who we are and whose we are in every aspect of our lives.

Jesus reminds us of this truth in our Gospel passage today as He cleverly puts the Pharisees in their place during their attempt to verbally entrap Him. They ask Him whether it is lawful to pay the tax to Caesar. But the Pharisees were thinking small. Christ, on the other hand, thinks big.

We all know how the story goes. Christ asks to see the coin that pays the tax and has them state whose image is on it. They of course, reply, "Caesar." In response Christ tells them to "Repay to Caesar what belongs to Caesar and to God what belongs to God."

With that, He reminds us that while civil authorities should be obeyed, we answer to an infinitely higher authority, God, Who is Lord of everything and everyone. All things and all people were created by God. In Baptism we have been claimed for Christ. Our lives are a gift from God and we have the privilege and responsibility to use every aspect of our lives in grateful response to Him.

Let us joyfully give thanks to this wonderful God by the way we live our daily lives. We belong to Him and there is no other!
